

Mr. Jacobson's 7th & 8th Grade Class



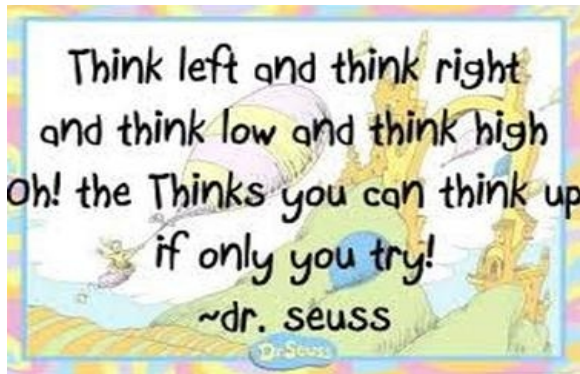

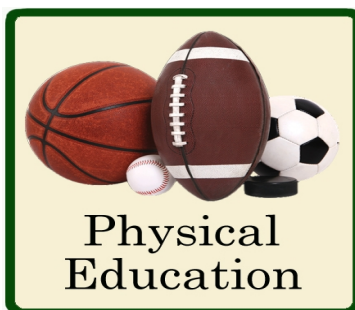


What To Expect This Year...
